



DURHAM POLICE DEPARTMENT FULL TIME POLICE OFFICER

The Durham, New Hampshire Police Department is seeking two officer candidates to fill vacancies in our agency. The applicants selected to serve as a Police Officer will provide law enforcement and community-oriented services to this diverse Seacoast/University community. The Durham Police Department is a Meritorious CALEA Accredited agency.

Officers patrol an assigned area for the purpose of crime prevention and law enforcement. Duties include but are not limited to the investigation of crimes; identification/apprehension of offenders; traffic enforcement and the provision of emergency services. Candidates must have the ability to exercise good judgment/common sense/discretion and be able to analyze situations quickly and objectively. Patrol Officers work a 4 day on 3 day off schedule. Special assignments include: Problem Oriented Police (POP), Detective Division, Special Response Team (SRT), Evidence Collection Team, Mountain Bike Patrol and School Resource Officer (SRO).

Applicants must be 21 years old by the anticipated date of appointment.

Applicants must be a high school graduate or hold a GED. Starting salary for a probationary officer is \$49,578. This salary does not include holiday pay, educational incentive, donning doffing pay, and if you choose, a generous insurance buyback option.
